The Richardson Racing League is an introduction to the Olympic Discipline of Flat water Canoeing and Kayaking. Local youth between the ages of 10-15 practice twice a week on teams of 20. Teams are taught by energetic, trained coaches. Participants learn basic canoeing and kayaking skills, meet new people, and have lots of FUN!



No previous experience is needed. We will teach you all the skills need.

Practices

Teams meet at the Lanier Canoe & Kayak Club twice a week. Each training session is 1.5 hours. At the sessions, participants get the opportunity to try out different equipment, practice skills, play games, and have fun. The Practice Schedule is determined at the beginning of each season and is posted on the LCKC website.

Regattas

Throughout the 6 weeks there are 2 competitions where participants showcase their skills:

May 2, 2009– Richardson Racing League Fun Race. The Fun race is a laid back opportunity for participants to get out and race and mix with the other teams.

May 16, 2009– Richardson Racing League Fungatta. The Fungatta is the final competition of the program. Awards are given out for individual events, and Teams race for the Team Burgee title. The Team Burgee can be taken back to their home school and displayed proudly!
