



Information on Media Photography at Competition Venue

Vests

- All accredited photographers on site are required to wear a photo vest provided by Lanier Canoe 2003. The vests will identify you as credentialed media and allow you access to key photo locations and to the photographers' boat (see below).
- Photo vests will be kept in the Media Center and distributed on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- When finished for the day, all photographers must return their photo vests to the Media Center.

Photography Boat

- Media photographers who wish to be on the water at any time during the competition must be accredited and have a Lanier Canoe 2003 photo vest to gain access to the photographers' boat.
- The photo boat will pick up and drop off every hour on the hour at the Fleet Dock.
- Photographers interested in shooting from the photography boat must sign up in advance (preferably the day before) to book a space on the boat.
- A sign-up schedule will be maintained in the Media Center and trips will be booked on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- The boat can carry a maximum of six photographers at one time.
- No one photographer can remain on the boat for two consecutive trips unless there is no one waiting to take his or her place.
- Because the photo boat cannot move during races, the boat will stop during each race. Each boat trip will progress from the finish line toward the start and back again during the one-hour period.

Photographers' Dock

- There will also be a photo dock located below the finish line. A shuttle boat, separate from the photography boat, will take photographers from the fleet dock to the photo dock and back again.
- The shuttle boat, like the photography boat, can accommodate up to six passengers at a time and will pick up and drop at the Fleet Dock.
- Unlike the photography boat, the shuttle boat can make several round trips each hour.
- To catch a ride to the photo dock, please be at the fleet dock wearing a photo vest and wait for the next shuttle boat.
